



- Roughly around March



### Study Time




- I credit hour = 50 min. of in-class time and 2.5-3 hours of study time


#### When do programs start and are there rolling admissions?

All programs for the Departments of Clinical and School Psychology start in the Fall without rolling admissions.

Applied Psychology Programs:

- The Organizational Psychology PsyD Program begins in the fall only, without rolling admissions.
- The Master of Applied Psychology Program begins in both the fall and spring, without rolling admissions.
- The Master of Applied Behavior Analysis Program begins in the fall only, without rolling admissions.
- The Accelerated Bachelor to Master of Applied Psychology Program begins in the fall and spring, without rolling admissions.
- The Applied Behavior Analysis Certificate begins in the fall and spring, with rolling admissions.



### **Types of Financial Aid**

Category	Explanation/Eligibility
Merit-Based Assistance (Fellowships, Assistantships, Scholarships)	<ul> <li>Awarded to students based on academic standing or special interests</li> <li>Students are automatically considered based or funding availability and various other factors</li> </ul>
Need-Based Assistance (Grants, Loans, Employment)	<ul> <li>Awarded to students based on demonstrated financial need/hardship</li> <li>U.S. citizens and permanent residents are eligible</li> <li>Students must report any further need-based assistance received from the Rutgers Office of Financial Aid on top of original award</li> </ul>
Non-Need-Based Assistance (Private Loans and Other Loan Sources)	<ul> <li>An option for students that allows for borrowing money with varied terms</li> <li>Money must be paid back with/without interest</li> </ul>


