


To the parents of our DDDC students,

We hope this e-mail finds you and your children well. We have determined that our first phase of reopening will involve a maximum of 25% of student capacity in each classroom. As we informed you last week, our goal is to have your child report to the center one day a week for the remaining three weeks of our extended school year program, beginning the week of July 27th. Your children will continue receiving remote support/instruction for the remaining 4 days each week. We will be eliminating the early dismissal on August 14th and replacing it with a full day to ensure that all students receive a full day of in-person services regardless of what day of the week they are assigned to attend school at our center. ## The Road to Reopening the DDDC



At this point we are doing everything we can in the next two week to be able to meet our goal of opening on July 27th. As has been the case for the duration of this pandemic, we all need to ensure our plan is flexible enough to respond to circumstances that are continually changing. Obtaining required Personal Protective Equipment for staff depends on staff fitting and medical evaluation which is underway. Specific PPE inventory may be impacted by supply chain challenges and shipments being diverted to medical facilities and hotspots. With so much unknown, we proceed with our opening plan with optimism but also with a realistic need to remain flexible should factors change which impact our ability to open safely. We will keep you posted as we gather new information and hope we see your children in person the week of July 27th.
